Confession of Faith Heidelberg Catechism, Questions 105 - 107

**Leader:** *What is God's will for you in the Sixth Commandment?*

**People:** I am not to belittle, insult, hate, or kill my neighbor (not by my thoughts, my words, my look or gesture, and certainly not by actual deeds) and I am not to be party to this in others; rather, I am to put away all desire for revenge. I am not to harm or recklessly endanger myself either. Prevention of murder is also why government is armed with the sword.

**Leader:** *Does this commandment refer only to killing?*

**People:** By forbidding murder God teaches us that He hates the root of murder: envy, hatred, anger, vindictiveness. In God's sight all such are murder.

**Leader:** *Is it enough then that we do not kill our neighbor in any such way?*

**People:** No. By condemning envy, hatred, and anger God tells us to love our neighbor as ourselves, to be patient, peace-loving, gentle, merciful, and friendly to them, to protect them from harm as much as we can, and to do good even to our enemies.
