***Confession of Faith** Heidelberg Catechism, Q. 23-25

Leader: *What are these articles?*
People: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only begotten Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Leader: *How are these articles divided?* (1)
People: Into three parts: God the Father and our creation; God the Son and our deliverance; God the Holy Spirit and our sanctification.

Leader: *Since there is only one divine being, why do you speak of three: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?* (2)
People: Because that is how God has revealed himself in his Word: these three distinct persons are one, true, eternal God.

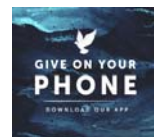

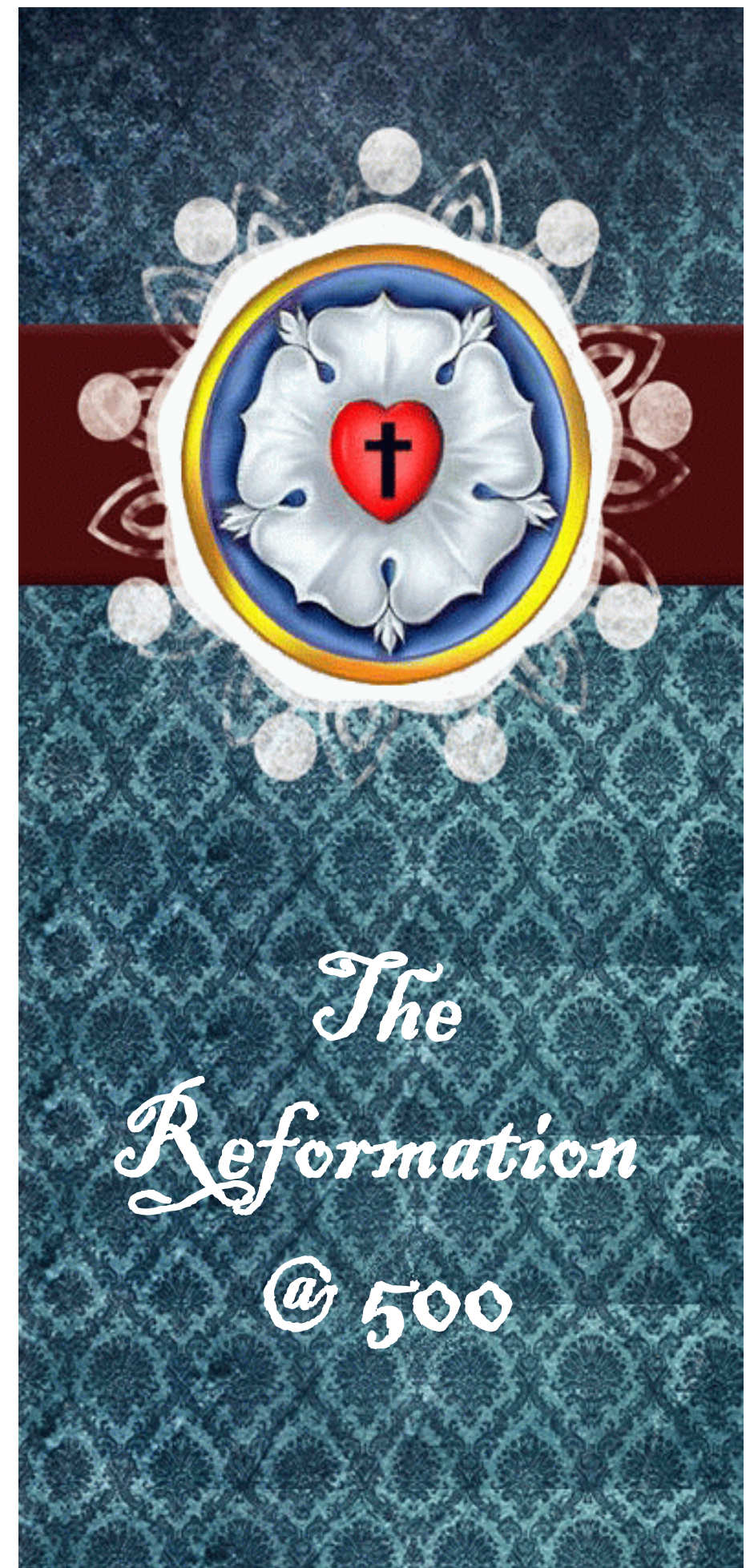
