*Confession of Faith

The Nicene Creed, Part I

Leader: The Nicene Creed, as written in AD 325 at the Council of Nicea and revised at the Council of Constantinople in AD 381, has been affirmed by the church throughout the ages, and thus serves as a good summary of the biblical and historical Christian faith. The beginning of each of the three sections of the Creed begins with an acknowledgment of each divine person of the Godhead.

So Christian, what do you believe concerning the One Triune God?

We believe in One God the Father almighty . . .

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God . . .

And in the Holy Spirit.

There is but one living and true God, the God revealed to us in the Scriptures. Our communion with God and our comfortable dependence on Him relies on the knowledge that He consists of three distinct Persons, of one substance, eternity, and unity: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and is thus rightly worshiped in Trinity. Although coequal in creation, sovereignty, holiness, wisdom, knowledge, justice, love, grace, mercy, and every other divine attribute and perfection, God, as Father, Son, and Spirit, has and continues to execute distinct and harmonious offices in the glorious work of redemption. And thus, as Creator and Redeemer, He is due from all humanity highest love, honor, and obedience. Amen.


