People: We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of the Father before all the worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation, came down from heaven, and was incarnate, by the Holy Spirit, of the virgin Mary, and was made man.

In the fullness of time, the Son of God, the second person of the Trinity, being fully and eternally God, of one substance and equal with the Father, conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary, became fully man, yet without sin. These two distinct natures, however, were joined together in one person, without change, separation, or confusion. Thus the person and nature of Jesus is very God, and very man, yet one Christ, the only mediator between God and man.

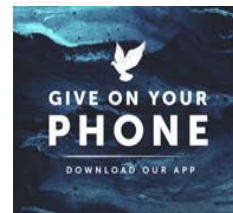
