***Confession of Faith** Heidelberg Catechism, Q. 9-11

Leader: *But doesn't God do man an injustice by requiring in His law what man is unable to do?* (2)

People: No, God created man with the ability to keep the law. Man, however, tempted by the devil, in reckless disobedience, robbed himself and his descendants of these gifts.

Leader: *Will God permit such disobedience and rebellion to go unpunished?* (3)

People: Certainly not. He is terribly angry about the sin we are born with as well as the sins we personally commit. As a just judge He punishes them now and in eternity. He has declared: "Cursed be every one who does not abide by all things written in the book of the law, and do them."

Leader: *But isn't God also merciful?* (4)

People: God is certainly merciful, but He is also just. His justice demands that sin, committed against His supreme majesty, be punished with the supreme penalty ~ eternal punishment of body and soul.

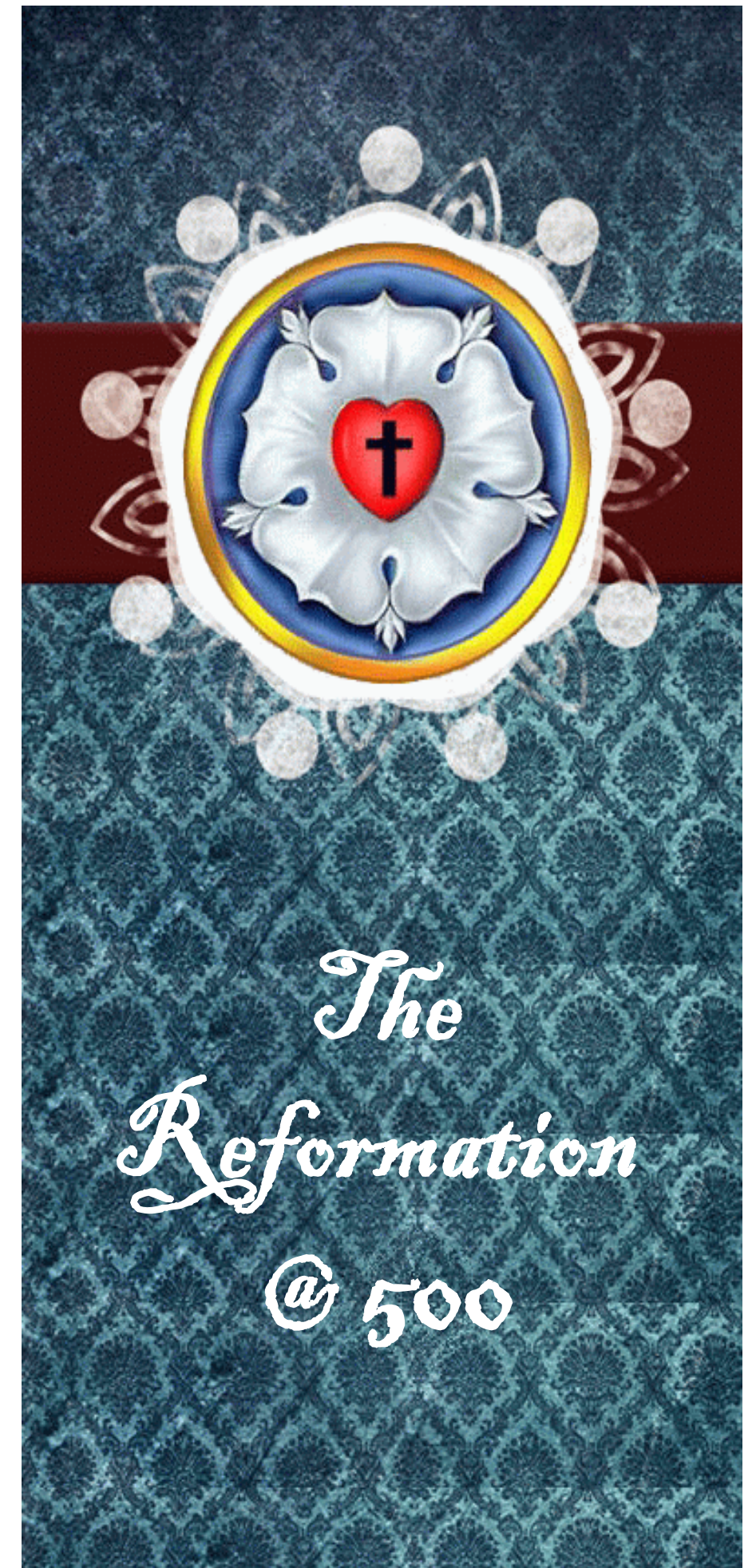
