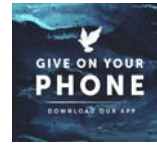

It's Flood Bucket Time!



Our Youth Group will be traveling to the MNA warehouse in Rome, GA on a mission trip in early June and will transport the items that we have been collecting since last fall. It's not too late to add to the supplies they will be taking. Here's a list of the monthly collections—feel free to contribute any of these items. Let's fill up their van!!

- January** 50 oz. liquid laundry detergent (2-25 oz. or 1-50 oz.)
- February** 5 gallon buckets with re-sealable lid (new buckets)
- March** insect repellent spray (6-14 oz) with protective cap
- April** air freshener (8-9 oz) with protective cap
- May** heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon), 24 bag roll
- June** disinfectant dish soap, 16-28 oz. plastic bottles
- July** household cleaners, 12-16 oz. plastic bottles
- August** plastic scouring pads (no soap) & cellulose sponges
- September** cleaning wipes (Handi-Wipe style, no terry cloth)
- October** clothes line & 50 clothes pins
- November** dust masks
- December** heavy-duty reusable latex gloves & leather work gloves

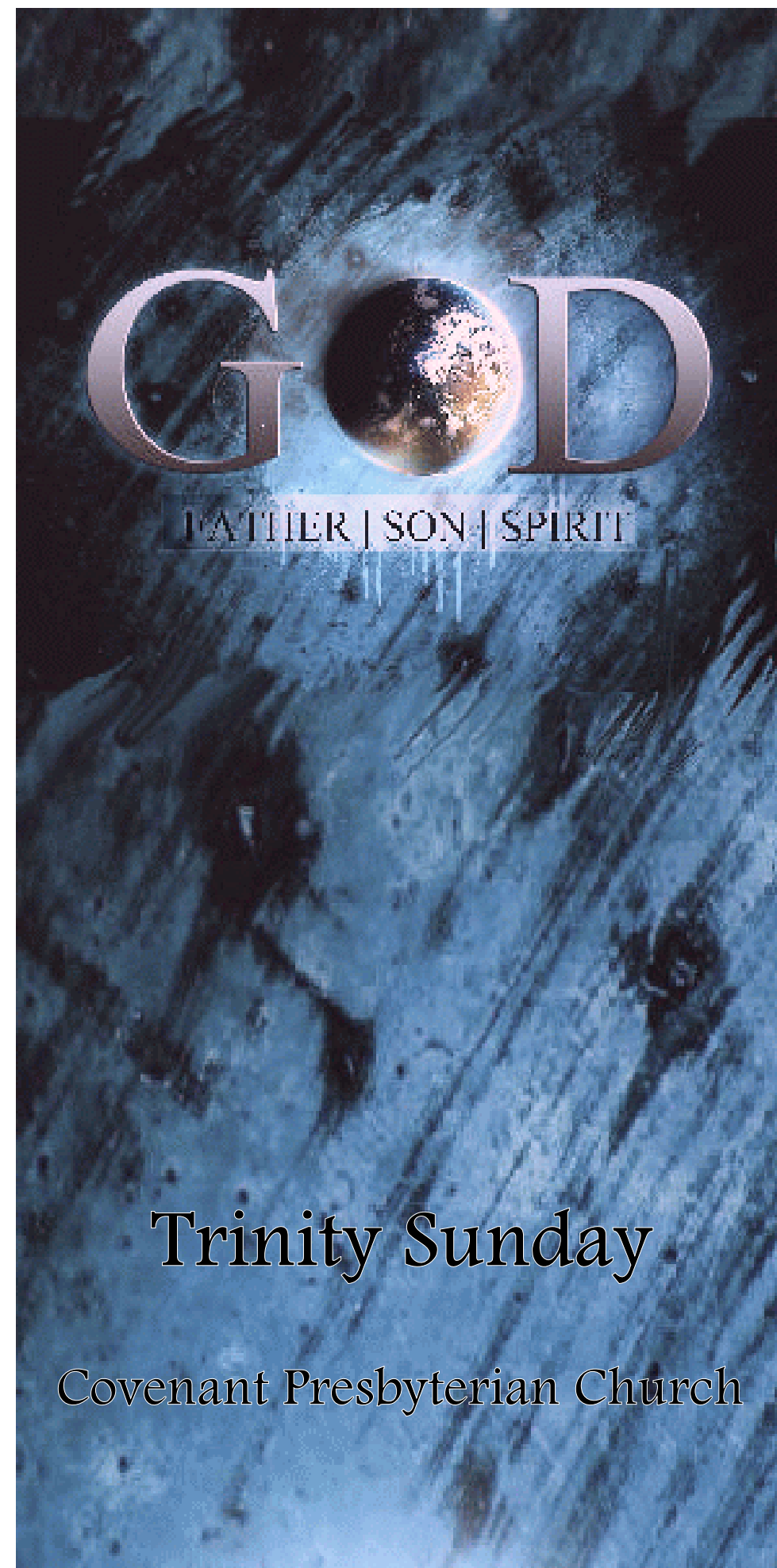


Each card cost \$10.00 and the Youth Group gets to keep \$6.00. Please see any member of the Covenant Youth Group to purchase yours!
