The Romans Series (68) Rev. Cory D. Colravy

Sermon Thesis: God has always saved sinners through the Gospel of justification by faith alone, as both the New and Old Testaments clearly demonstrate.

Introduction:

I. The Gospel of Genesis in the Life of Abraham (vv. 1~5): Genesis 15:6.
