Belgic Confession, Question #26C

Leader: People:

Christian, what do you believe about the intercession of Christ?

We believe that we have no access to God except through the one and only Mediator and Intercessor, "Jesus Christ the righteous". We should not plead here that we are unworthy [to be heard by God in prayer]—for it is not a question of offering our prayers on the basis of our own dignity but only on the basis of the excellence and dignity of Jesus Christ, whose righteousness is ours by faith. Since the apostle for good reason wants us to get rid of this foolish fear—or rather, this unbelief—he says to us that Jesus Christ was made like "his brothers and sisters in every respect, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest" to purify the sins of the people. For since he suffered, being tempted, he is also able to help those who are tempted.
